Within an international research team (coordinated by Prof. dr. Ilse Derluyn, Ghent University, Belgium) and based in Gent (Belgium), the post-doc researcher will be responsible for the overall coordination of the project, including the close follow-up of the different tasks within the project as executed by the different consortium members (i.e., set-up, implementation and evaluation of school-based psychosocial interventions), reporting to the European Commission, data analysis and reporting, and dissemination activities (website, newsletters, workshops,...).
